His particular field is economics of agriculture. The input-output analyses led him to agribusiness. He is one of the pioneers of food economics in Hungary. He is thinking in the context of world economy. Some of his research results contributed to the development of a sound Hungarian agricultural policy. Between 2001-2006 he was analysing the agricultural policy of Japan 1950-2000. Since 2006 he has dealing with Hungary's agricultural policy 1945-2005.

As acknowledgement of his activity as university teacher he became titular university professor in 1983, later in 1997 university private professor; in 2003 got appointment to the Szeged University as university professor. Finally in 2005 he became titular professor at West-Hungarian University.
